

Nova Scotia Crop and Livestock Insurance Commission Wildlife Compensation Policy For Bees and Beehives – 2025 update

Provided that all other requirements are satisfied for a compensation payment, the following chart will be used to determine the maximum claim payment for honeybee hives.

Claim calculations will be made based on the actual parts of a honeybee hive lost to eligible wildlife damage.
